# Examples: What are we already doing which supports these goals?

We are already...

- Offering targeted development support and mentoring to staff
- Committing to ambitious targets for access and participation for students from under-represented backgrounds
- Increasing our investment in support for equality, diversity and inclusion (EDI), with dedicated Pro-Vice-Chancellor leadership

We are already...

- Offering an increasing range of degree apprenticeships to prospective students and employers
- Continuing to invest in the Nottingham Advantage Award to give our students an edge in the employment market
- Working with Students as Change Agents to innovate in the delivery of learning and teaching

We are already...

- Implementing an ambitious programme to increase the scale, quality and reach of our research
- Creating and supporting high quality space for researchers and students to work with local entrepreneurs and to partner in larger scale innovation
- Working in partnership with Nottingham Trent University through 'Universities for Nottingham' to develop a civic engagement plan

We are already...

- Bringing together researchers through our Beacons of Excellence to address all of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals
- Reducing our reliance on singleuse plastics and promoting waste reduction through nudges like our 'latte levy'
- Ensuring that any new buildings are constructed to BREEAM<sup>2</sup> 'excellent' standard for sustainability

We are already...

- Encouraging and supporting trans-disciplinary research programmes including through our Beacons of Excellence
- Investing in shared learning, teaching and laboratory spaces which bring together students, researchers and teachers across disciplines
- Raising school attainment in our local community as a successful academy sponsor

We are already...

- Recruiting our students from over 150 different countries
- Partnering with some of the most successful universities globally through Universitas 21, which includes access to high quality international placements for undergraduates
- Working with top universities and research institutes worldwide, with more than half of our publications co-authored with international partners

# What ideas have been suggested during the consultation in line with these goals?

We could...

- Recruit all UK undergraduate students via contextualised offers
- Recruit to all staff posts using anonymised applications
- Offer a foundation year for talented students who need some extra preparation, with their final year of study offered free so that they do not pay more overall

We could...

- Make all our programmes genuinely accessible on a parttime and flexible basis, using technology to support this
- Give all alumni lifetime access to our online learning resources
- Offer every student a paid placement with an employer, in one of our research teams or with an international partner

We could...

- Set up a research funding support unit to deliver a step change in the external financing of our research activities including major facilities
- Offer all students access to support and training for setting up their own businesses
- Develop an innovation hub in the centre of Nottingham

We could...

- Require carbon offset purchase for all business travel
- Conduct an environmental impact assessment for all significant proposed investments
- Include relevant learning on sustainability as part of all our undergraduate programmes

We could...

- Create spaces designed to promote collaboration which are accessible to all students and staff
- Offer all Nottingham students a common module they would study with those from other subject disciplines and campuses. Options could include critical thinking, sustainability, research and business skills
- Promote shared professional development across all staff groups, including developing a shadowing/mentoring approach which would partner academics with professional services and technical staff and bring together staff based in different countries

We could...

- Create a sabbatical leave entitlement to be used to develop new international research partnerships
- Offer every University of Nottingham student an international opportunity – perhaps a module studied together with students in another international location, or a study abroad option
- Review our curriculum content and our research narratives to ensure they are free of colonial attitudes and assumptions

The strategy will be supported by a series of strategic delivery plans. Where these are already in place (eg the Research Vision), they will be refreshed in light of the new strategy. The application of these plans to UNUK, UNNC and UNM will vary and be determined in line with the 'one University, three countries' principle.
