

- ✓ Seminar (the small lessons you have, in a classroom)
- √ Halls of residence (the place where you live at university)





- ✓ Catered (where the food is cooked for you in the halls of residence)
- ✓ Self-catered (where you cook your own meals in kitchens in the halls of residence)
